James Monroe – 5<sup>th</sup> president

James Buchanan – 15<sup>th</sup> president James Buchanan was born in Apr 23, 1791, he fought in the war of 1812 and died Jun 01, 1868.

Rutherford B. Hayes – 19<sup>th</sup> president


