**A:** I don't have a big specific plan but I do want to paten it and sell it.

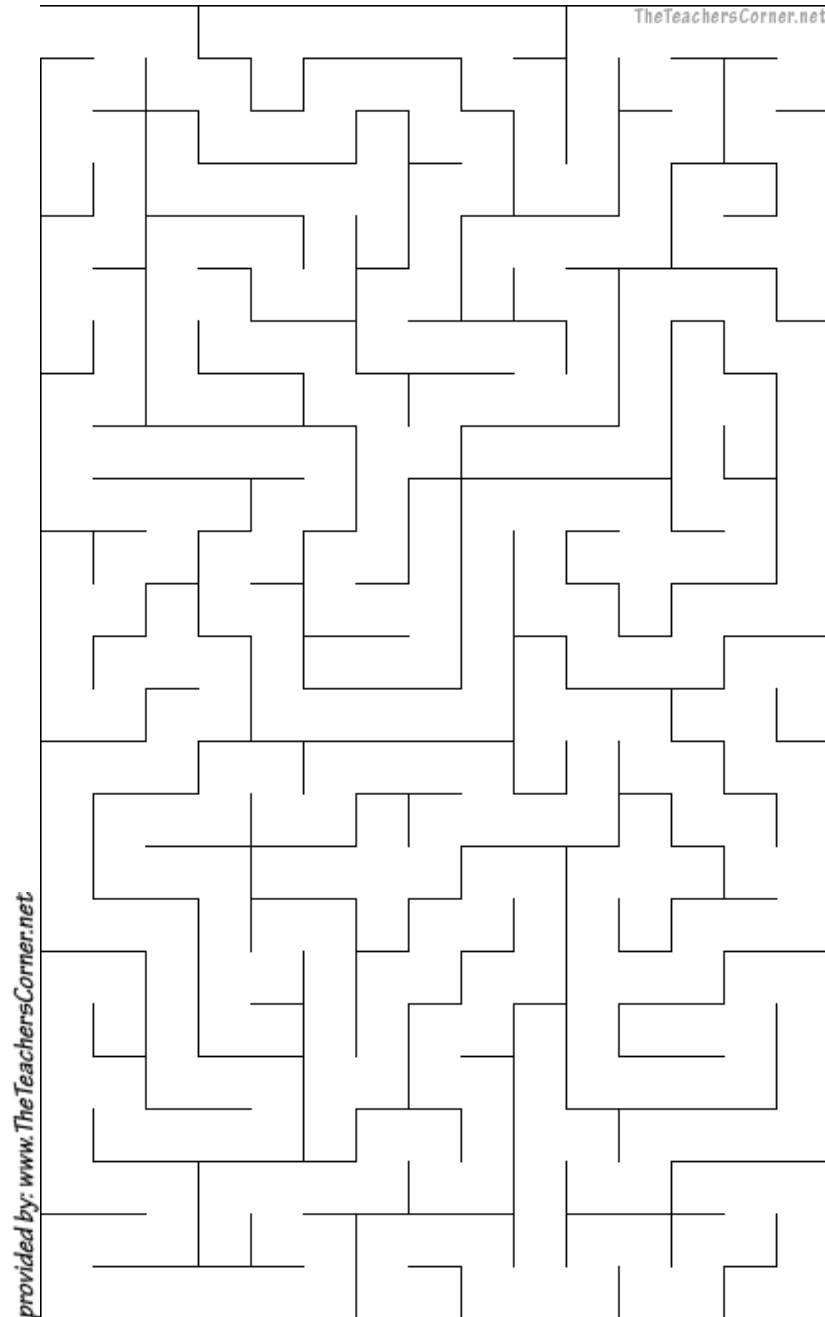
