

Mac Forehand was born in Norwalk. He is 20 years old. He is a lifelong skier and started freestyle skiing when he was six. He made the U.S. Free Ski Team at the age of 17. He dedicated his high school years to practicing. He also likes to skateboard and mountain bike. He is an Olympic freestyle skier and competes in the big air and slopestyle events. He has been on the USA team for 4 years.
